


Morning Service Sunday 7th June 2020 – Trinity Sunday

Introduction by a Guide leader

PENITENCE led by Cubs

Reader 1 If we say we have never been selfish,
we are not speaking the truth.
If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just.

Reader 2 Lord God, our maker and our redeemer,

Reader 1 We have seen others being treated badly and bullied.
We have not helped them as we should:
Lord, be merciful: **forgive us our sin.**

Reader 2 We have not stood up against evil,
or spoken up for the poor and oppressed;
Lord, be merciful: **forgive us our sin.**

Reader 1 We have heard the good news of Jesus Christ,
but have failed to tell other people about Him;
Lord, be merciful: **forgive us our sin.**

Reader 2 We have not loved you with all our heart,
we have not loved others the way we love ourselves;
Lord, be merciful: **forgive us our sin.**

ABSOLUTION

God who is both power and love,
forgive you and free you from your sins,
heal and strengthen you by his Spirit,
and raise you to new life in Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

The first reading is from Philippians chapter 4 beginning to read at verse 8

8 Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honourable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. ⁹Keep on doing the things that you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and the God of peace will be with you.

... I have learned to be content with whatever I have. ¹²I know what it is to have little, and I know what it is to have plenty. In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being well-fed and of going hungry, of having plenty and of being in need. ¹³I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

Hear the Gospel of our Saviour Christ, according to Saint Matthew, chapter 28, beginning to read at verse 20.

Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

The eleven disciples went to the hill in Galilee where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him, even though some of them doubted. Jesus drew near and said to them, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And I will be with you always, to the end of the age."
