Good morning!

... and welcome to our service of Morning Worship with the Sacrament of Holy Baptism.

We especially welcome the parents, god-parents, family and friends of

Alice Lily Elaine KENNEDY,

who comes for baptism today.

Baptism marks the beginning of a journey with God which continues for the rest of our lives, the first step in our response to God's love. Each of us has a responsibility to ensure that all baptised children are nurtured in the faith. It is the work of the Christian community, and not just for parents and god-parents.

So let us join with **Alice** and her family today, in joy and celebration, and in a renewal of our own commitment to Christ.

WELCOME & INTRODUCTION GREETING

God is Spirit.

Let us worship him in spirit and in truth.

THE FIRST READING Colossians 1: 11-20

The first reading is from the letter of St. Paul to the Colossians, Chapter 1, reading from verse 11

¹¹ being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, ¹² and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light. ¹³ For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

¹⁵ The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. ¹⁶ For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. ¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. ¹⁸ And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. ¹⁹ For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, ²⁰ and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

THE BAPTISM

At the baptism of an infant the following is said: Our Lord Jesus Christ has told us that to enter the kingdom of heaven we must be born again of water and the Spirit, and has given us baptism as the sign and seal of this new birth. Here we are washed by the Holy Spirit and made clean. Here we are clothed with Christ, dying to sin that we may live his risen life. As children of God, we have a new dignity and God calls us to fullness of life. Holy Baptism is administered to infants on the understanding that they will be brought up in the fellowship of Christ's Church; that they will be taught the Christian faith; and that, when they have publicly confessed this faith, they will be confirmed by the bishop and admitted to the Holy Communion.

THE PRESENTATION

Parents and godparents, will you accept the responsibilities placed upon you in bringing **Alice Elaine Lily Kennedy** for baptism and answer on her behalf. By your own prayers and example, by your teaching and love, will you encourage her in the life and faith of the Christian community?

With the help of God, we will.

In baptism this child begins her journey in faith. You speak for her today. Will you care for her, and help her to take her place within the life and worship of Christ's Church? With the help of God, we will.

⁴⁰ But the other criminal rebuked him. 'Don't you fear God,' he said, 'since you are under the same sentence? ⁴¹ We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong.'

THE DECISION

In baptism, God calls us from darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him. Therefore I ask:

Do you reject the devil and all proud rebellion against God? I reject them.

Do you renounce the deceit and corruption of evil? I renounce them.

Do you repent of the sins that separate us from God and neighbour? I repent of them.

Do you turn to Christ as Saviour? I turn to Christ.

Do you submit to Christ as Lord? I submit to Christ.

Do you come to Christ, the Way, the Truth and the Life? I come to Christ.

The presiding minister says to the congregation

You have heard these our brothers and sisters respond to Christ. Will you support them in this calling?

The congregation answers We will support them.

THE BAPTISM

Water is poured into the font.

Praise God who made heaven and earth. Who keeps his promise for ever.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give our thanks and praise. $_{7}$ We give you thanks that at the beginning of creation your Holy Spirit moved upon the waters to bring forth light and life.

With water you cleanse and replenish the earth; you nourish and sustain all living things.

Thanks be to God.

We give you thanks that through the waters of the Red Sea you led your people out of slavery into freedom, and brought them through the river Jordan to new life in the land of promise.

Thanks be to God.

We give you thanks for your Son Jesus Christ: for his baptism by John, for his anointing with the Holy Spirit.

Thanks be to God.

We give you thanks that through the deep waters of death Jesus delivered

us from our sins and was raised to new life in triumph.

Thanks be to God.

We give you thanks for the grace of the Holy Spirit who forms us in the

likeness of Christ and leads us to proclaim your Kingdom.

Thanks be to God.

And now we give you thanks that you have called this your servant Amelia to new birth in your Church through the waters of baptism.

Pour out your Holy Spirit in blessing and sanctify this water so that she who is baptized in it may be made one with Christ in his death and resurrection. May she die to sin, rise to newness of life, and continue for ever in Jesus Christ our Lord, through whom we give you praise and honour in the unity of the Spirit, now and for ever. **Amen.**

The presiding minister shall ask the following question to **the parents** and god-parents:

Do you believe and accept the Christian faith into which *Alice Elaine Lily Kennedy* is to be baptized?

I do.



The presiding minister addresses the congregation.

Brothers and sisters, I ask you to profess, together with these sponsors the faith of the Church.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father? I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son? I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come again to judge the living and the dead. Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit? I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The presiding minister says

Name this child

The presiding minister baptizes by pouring water over them, saying

Alice Elaine Lily Kennedy I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Christ claims you for his own.

Receive the sign of the cross.

Live as a disciple of Christ, fight the good fight, finish the race, keep the faith.

Confess Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, look for his coming in glory.

The minister continues.
God has called you into his Church.

The congregation joins the minister, saying We therefore receive and welcome you as a member with us of the body of Christ, as a child of the one heavenly Father, and as an inheritor of the kingdom of God.

THE PEACE

We are the body of Christ. By one spirit we were all baptised into one body. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life together.

The peace of the Lord be always with you and also with you.

PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

The following prayers are said:

Father, we thank you that **Alice Elaine Lily Kennedy** has now been born again of water and the Holy Spirit, and has become your own child by adoption, and a member of your Church.

Grant that she may grow in the faith in which she has been baptized; Grant that she herself may confess it when she comes to be confirmed; Grant that she may bear witness to it by a life of service to others; and that all things belonging to the Spirit may live and grow in her; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.

Almighty God, bless the home of this child, and give such grace and wisdom to all who have the care of her, that by their word and good example they may teach her to know and love you, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

THE LORD'S PRAYER

As our Saviour Christ has taught us, we are bold to say Our Father, who art in heaven: hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done,

on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread.

And forgive us our trespasses


